

## RECYCLING IN LITTLETON

- Effective April 1, 2000 Massachusetts State Regulation 310 CMR 19.017 prohibits the disposal, or transfer for disposal the following materials
  - Glass Containers
  - Metal Containers
  - Narrow-neck Plastic Containers
    - Recyclable Paper
    - Yard Waste and Leaves
    - Lead Acid Batteries
    - White Goods (appliances)
      - Tires
  - Cathode Ray Tubes (TV and Computer Monitors)
  
- The following materials are **NOT** Acceptable in any container
  - Sheetrock and Wallboard
  - Fiberglass Insulation
  - Asphalt Shingles
  - Asphalt Pavement
  - Brick and/or Concrete
  
- The following materials **MUST** be recycled:
  - Glass (Bottles and Jars only)
  - Tin and Aluminum Cans
  - Plastics (31 and #2 only)
  - Newspaper, cardboard and mixed paper
    - Yard Waste (grass and Leaves)
      - Brush (Fee)
      - Appliances (Fee)
    - Tires (16 inch maximum, Fee)
    - Used Motor Oil and Antifreeze
      - Scrap Metal
  - Returnable Cans and Bottles (for non-profit groups)
  - Cathode Ray Tubes (TV's and Computer Monitors, Fee)
  
- Salvation Army containers are also on site for reusable clothing
