Edward T. Hinckley, 82, of 25 Dogwood Road, Littleton, died Wednesday, Dec. 20, 2000, at Life Care Center of Nashoba Valley in Littleton. He was the husband of the late Mary (Lineham) Hinckley, who died in 1980.

Born in Brighton on May 29, 1918, he was the son of the late Waldo and Leda (Eastman) Hinckley. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II and fought in the Battle of the Bulge. He lived in Littleton for more than 50 years and prior to retirement many years ago was employed by M.J. Leahy Trucking Co., Littleton.
