David W. Hartwell Sr., 74, of Acton, died suddenly Tuesday, Feb. 22, 2000, at Emerson Hospital in Concord. He was the husband of Nancy (Smith) Hartwell.

Born in Arlington, he was the son of the late Warren and Virginia (Chamberlin) Hartwell. He graduated from Arlington High School and enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corp during World War I. He served with the VMB 61 Bomb Squadron and was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and Air Medal. After the war he attended Tufts University where he received a degree in business administration. He worked as an administrator for Housing and Urban Development in Medford for 20 years, planning to retire in March. He also worked for the town of Concord. He was a member of the VMB 611 Group and the Maynard Country Club.

In addition to his wife, M. Hartwell is survived by a son, David W. Hartwell Jr. of Bolton; three daughters, Janice Hartwell of Ft. Meyers, Fla., Marsha Taylor of Newmarket, N.H., and Lynn Hartwell of Somerville; six stepchildren; two sisters, Phyllis W. Rich of Rockville, Conn., and Doris E. Osborn of Marlboro; and four grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Feb. 26, at the Badger Funeral Home in Littleton with burial following at Westlawn Cemetery, Littleton.
