

Harold Hansen...1933-1995

Harold Hansen, 61, of Abenaki Trail, Littleton, died suddenly at Deaconess Nashoba Hospital in Ayer on Jan. 5, 1995.

He was born in Cambridge on Dec. 5, 1933, the son of Mary (Peace) Hansen of Falmouth and the late Harry Hansen Sr.
