Edward J. Iverson Sr.

Edward J. Iverson Sr., 62, of 239 Ayer Road died Monday, August 6, at the Nashoba Community Hospital in Ayer following a brief illness. He was born in Ayer, March 30, 1922, the son of the late Edward and Anne (Keaveny) Iverson.

He had made his home in Littleton for the last 30 years and had lived his early life in Ayer. He attended the Ayer Public Schools. Mr. Iverson worked as a store manager and had just retired recently from the Towne & Country Family Center in Littleton. He had previously worked at the First National Markets, 15 years with the Post Exchange Services at Ft. Devens in Ayer, and 12 years at the Ayer Market.

A Veteran of World War II, he served as a Sargeant in the Army Air Corp. with the 34th Bomb Group 391st Bomb Squadron attached to the Eight Air Force where he was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross during the Battle of Normandy.

Mr. Iverson was an active

member and Treasurer of the Littleton Lion's Club. He was also a member of St. Anne's Parish in Littleton.

He is survived by his wife, Aileen R. (O'Keefe) Iverson of Littleton, 2 sons, Edward J. Iverson Jr. of Ayer and William P. Iverson of Littleton, 5 daughters, Annmarie Iverson of Boylston, Kathy Iverson of Westboro, Aileen Iverson Nason of Clinton, Margaret J. Iverson of Littleton and Mary Iverson Berry of Littleton, 1 brother, John J. Iverson of Shirley and 8 grandchildren.

Funeral Mass was held Thursday, August 9 at 10:00 A.M. at St. Anne's Church in Littleton. Visiting hours were held Tues. 7-9 and Wed. 2-4 and 7-9 at the Badger Funeral Home, Rte 2A, Littleton. Burial was in Westlawn Cemetery, Littleton.
