# Priscilla Kimball

Priscilla (Stone) Kimball, 85, of 415 Newtown Road, Littleton, died at Apple Valley Continuing Care Center in Ayer on Oct. 15, 1993.

She was born in Littleton on Nov. 1, 1908, daughter of the late Edward and Gertrude (Wright) Stone.
