Helen (Fellows) Lyons, 77, of Green Needles Road, Littleton, died April 13 at the Nashoba Community Hospital in Ayer after a brief illness.

She was born in Melrose February 9, 1910, daughter of the late William and Nettie (Yeaton) Fellows, and was the wife of the late Harold E. Lyons, who died in 1968.

She had spent her early life in Melrose and was a graduate of Melrose High School Class of 1928.
