LITTLETON — Patricia (Johnson) LaPierre, 69, of Littleton, who had worked in the treasurer's office in two communities, died yesterday at Life Care Center of Nashoba Valley. She was the wife of Robert W. LaPierre of Littleton.

She was born in Winchendon, on Feb. 21, 1935, a daughter of the late Walter and Florence (Knight) Johnson. She grew up in Winchendon, and graduated from Appleton Academy, in New Ipswich, N.H.

Mrs. LaPierre was married in 1956 to Robert LaPierre, and subsequently lived in Greenville, N.H., Ann Arbor, Mich. for three years, and in Littleton since 1961.

Mrs. LaPierre worked for the Dana Hardy Insurance Co., for several years, and ran the Yankee Artisan, which sold New England crafts and craft supplies during the 1970's.

She later worked for the Town of Littleton in the treasurer's office, and then in the Town of Concord treasurer's office, retiring in 1995.
