Latin teacher for many years

Caroline Conant Minnisch, 96, died at the New Hampshire Odd Fellows Home on April 11, 1998.

She was born in Littleton, on Oct. 18, 1901. She was the widow of the late Don Minnisch and the daughter of Nelson Brainard and Nellie Fales Conant.

She graduated from Tufts College in 1923 and was employed in New Jersey by the Long Branch Board of Education for many years as a teacher of Latin in the high school. She was a life member of the Jackson College Association of Tufts University Alumnae, Inc., a member of the Delta Chapter of Alpha Omicron Pi, and a member of the Presbyterian Church of Long Branch, N.J. where she had served as a deacon.

Her closest survivors are Joyce Lovejoy of New Boston; N. H., Roger Conant of Littleton; and Joan Davison of Kapolei, Hawaii.
