LITTLETON — Paul E. Meyers Sr., 84, died on August 3 at Deaconess Nashoba Hospital in Ayer. He was the husband of Dorothy (Dauphine) Meyers of Littleton.



He was born in Cambridge on Oct. 17, 1916, a son of the late Charles and Alice (Connelly) Meyers. He grew up in Cambridge and attended the Morse School and Rindge Tech. He worked in a stocking mill in Jamaica Plain and Gloucester before serving in the Army during World War II.

Mr. Meyers worked in Civil Service in plumbing and sheet metal at Hanscom Field in Bedford and retired at the age of 56. He made his home in Littleton since 1955. He was a member of the Concord Rod and Gun Club, Veterans of Foreign Wars, St. Anne's Church of Littleton and the Blessed Sacrament Club of Cambridge.
