LITTLETON — Donald E. Meyers, 75, a resident of Littleton for 50 years who formerly lived in Lexington, died yesterday,



Feb. 25, at UMass Medical Center. He was the husband of

Frances (Howell) Meyers, to whom he was married for 27 years.

He was born in Westchester, Pa., Sept. 23, 1929, a son of the late Edwin and Mary (Kelley) Meyers. He grew up in Connecticut and was a graduate of Carson Long Military Academy in Woodbury, Conn. He attended Wesleyan University and received a degree in electrical engineering from the University of Connecticut.

Mr. Meyers served in the U.S. Air Force from 1948 until 1952.

He was an electrical engineer in the research department at Sylvania for 20 years and at Megapulse in Bedford for 18 years. He retired in 1991.

He was an avid reader, bridge player and bowler, and enjoyed motorcycling and woodworking.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his children and their spouses, Brian T. Meyers of Groton, Randy and Karen Meyers of Groton, Jeri Ann and Frank Carpenter of Lancaster, and Robin and John Sewell of Littleton; and eight grandchildren.
