

Eleanor McNamara ...former owner of Littleton motel; 91

JAFFREY, N.H. — Eleanor (Hansen) McNamara, 91, of Jaffrey, N.H., formerly of Littleton, Mass., where she operated a motel in the 1960s, died yesterday, July 7, at the Good Shepherd Home in Jaffrey.

Born in Cambridge on June 26, 1908, a daughter of the late John and Alice (Wallace) Hansen. She spent her early life in Cambridge and was married at age 30 to her former husband, Royce McNamara. Eleanor moved to Carolina to work in the Hotel industry and then made her home in Littleton in 1953.
