Virginia (Fisher) McKay, 82, of 191 Foster Street, died Sunday, Oct. 3 at Littleton House Nursing Home after a lengthy illness.

She was born in Littleton on Feb. 15, 1911, daughter of the late Leander and Catherine (Caveney) Fisher.

A lifelong resident of Littleton, Mrs. McKay was a graduate of Littleton High School Class of 1928. She worked as an inspector at United Elastics Corp. of Littleton for 28 years, then worked for Bowmar, Inc. of Acton for eight years, retiring in 1978.
