John Joseph McDonough

... worked in Littleton school system; 80

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — John Joseph McDonough, 80, formerly of Littleton, died Friday, March 24. He was the widower of Brigida (Dorigo) McDonough, who died on June 27, 1999.



He was born in South Boston on April 23, 1919, a son of Walter McDonough and Catherine Flaharty of County Galway, Ireland.

Mr. McDonough was a 22-year U.S. Army veteran. He served in World War II and fought in the Battle of the Bulge. He was awarded the Bronze Star, Purple Star and Army Commendation medals.

He worked for the Littleton school system from 1966 until he retired in 1981.

Survivors include a son and daughter-in-law, John C. and Charlene McDonough of Merrimack, N.H.; two daughters and a son-in-law, Marge McDonough-Shaw of Ayer, and Joann McDonough-Pratt and Robert Pratt of Kansas City, Mo.; two grandchildren, Kaitlin and Jack McDonough of Merrimack, N.H.; and a sister, Mary Landers of South Boston.

He was also the grandfather of Sean Leachman, who died in 1994.
