LITTLETON — Charles E. Andrews, 72, died Wednesday at the University of Massachusetts Medical Center in Worcester following a lengthy illness.

He was born in Nashua, N.H., Sept. 1, 1916, son of the late Forest and Eva (Blodgett) Andrews.

He spent his early life in Fitchburg and Groton, then resided in Arizona before returning to Massachusetts.

He joined the U.S. Army at the age of 19. After 23 years in the service, he retired in 1958 with the rank of captain.

Mr. Andrews was employed by Moore's Lumber in Littleton for 10 years and later as a mail carrier for the Littleton Post Office for 10 years. Most recently he had worked at Ray's Package Store in Pepperell.

He was a member of the Littleton Grange, the Littleton Congre-

gational Church, the VFW and the American Legion.
