Alva M. MacPhee

...of Ayer, was milkman 30 years; 96

AYER — Alva M. MacPhee, 96, an Ayer resident who made deliveries for three decades as a milkman, died yesterday, Aug. 9, at the Apple Valley Nursing Home in Ayer after a brief illness. He was the husband of the late Lattie (Robbins) MacPhee.

He was born in Lexington on Aug. 16, 1903, and received his education in the Lexington school system. Mr. MacPhee, formerly of Lunenburg, was employed for 30 years with Hood Milk as a delivery man. After retiring from Hood, he made deliveries for Parts Rebuilders until retirement at age 65 in 1969.

Mr. MacPhee was a member of the Ayer Masons Lodge. He was also a longtime member of The Federated Church of Ayer.

He is survived by a brother, Emery MacPhee of Halifax, Nova Scotia; seven grandchildren; as well as 16 great-grandchildren.

He was the father of the late Ruth Metcalf of Ayer and Marjorie Imhoff of Shirley.
