Andrew H. Andersen ...resident of Littleton; 92

LITTLETON — Andrew H. Andersen, a veteran of World War II who was a resident of Littleton since 1961, died Wednesday, Nov. 10, at the Life Care Center of Nashoba Valley in Littleton. He was 92.

 He was born Jan. 29, 1912, son of the late Thomas and Helga (Petersen) Andersen. He was raised in Somerville and graduated from Somerville High School in 1930. He worked various jobs before joining the Army.

During World War II, Mr. Andersen served as a corporal in the 14th Tank Battalion and was awarded a Silver Star and Purple Heart.

He was a machinist at Meisel Press in Dorchester for many years and also worked at Massachusetts General Hospital for 10 years.

Survivors include a son, Thomas A. Andersen of Portland, Ore.; a daughter, Christine E. Andersen of Hamburg, Germany; a sister, Louise O'Connell of Chelmsford; and a niece, Patricia O'Connell of Chelmsford.
