Hello Planning Board Members,

I am writing to express concerns with the proposed design of Northern Bank at 289 Great Road. Specifically, I am concerned that the plan shows a curb cut onto Robinson Road to be used as an exit for the bank traffic. As you can see from the pictures below, the parking for the existing dentist office is along the side of the road, there are (and will be for years to come) several school aged children on the street who wait for the bus in this area (at least 2 pick ups and drop offs a day), and Robinson Road is a narrow street that is barely wide enough for 2 vehicles to pass through. Although it appears to be a quiet dead end street it is in fact filled with many active families and this proposed traffic flow presents a serious safety concern for all of us.
