

Harold F. Nordberg, 93, of Acton, formerly of Maynard died Thursday July 17, 2003 after a long battle with prostate cancer. He was the husband of Mary Morrison (Ott) Nordberg.

Mr. Nordberg was born in Maynard, the son of August and Hilda Nordberg. He graduated from Maynard High School, and the Bentley School of Accounting and Finance. He served in the Army Finance Corps during World War II. He retired as a vice-president in the Boston office of Paine Webber, Jackson and Curtis after 46 years with the firm.

He was an active member of Union Congregational Church of Maynard, where he was a deacon emeritus and served in many other leadership positions. He was a member of the Charles A. Welch Masonic Lodge and the Maynard Historical Society, and had served on the Board of Trustees of the Assabet Institution for Savings, the Board of Directors of the Massachusetts Congregational Conference, and the Acton Board of Appeals.

Besides his wife he is survived by two daughters, Judith A. Nordberg of San Diego, Ca., and Susan M. Ott of Petersham, Ma., a son Robert A. Nordberg of Keene, N.H., five grandchildren, and four great grand children.

A memorial service will be held in the Union Congregational Church (UCC) in Maynard at 2 p.m. on Saturday, July 26, with The Rev. Margaret Flad presiding. Burial will be in the Westlawn Cemetery in Littleton, Ma. Visiting hours are Friday from 7 to 9 p.m. at Fowler-Kennedy Funeral Home, Maynard.
