Edwin H. Priest 20 June '47

Edwin H. Priest of Foster street, one of the community's older and better-known residents and husband of the late Mary Freeman Priest, died yesterday at the Community Memorial hospital. Born in Littleton and educated in its school system, he served his native town for many years as chairman of the boards of selectmen, public welfare, assessors and as town auditor. He was born Sept. 12, 1865, the son of the late Joseph A. and Mary Bigelow Priest. He leaves a daughter, Mrs. Andrew Landinnt of Foster street, Littleton; a son, Warren F.
