PEPPERELL— Emma (Philbrick) Pickard, 89, died Tuesday, Feb. 13, at Genesis House in Westford. She was the widow of Hobart L. Pickard, who died in 1968.

She was born in Milford, N.H., on Sept. 5 1911, a daughter of the late Fred D. and Elizabeth (Frost) Philbrick. She was graduated from Concord-Carlisle High School. Mrs. Pickard had lived in Billerica, Carlisle and Littleton, and was a longtime resident of Pepperell.
