Elsie Webb Pickard, 72, of 91 Bruce Street died at her residence Feb. 13 after a lengthy illness. She was born in Lowell, June 3, 1913 daughter of the late Francis and Mary (Williamson) Webb and was the wife of the late Ashley H. Pickard. Elsie had made her home in Littleton since 1928 and had been a first and second grade school teacher in Littleton from 1935 to 1977. She was a graduate of the Perry Normal School and a member of the Mass. Retired Teacher's Association and the National Retired Teacher's Association.
