Paul R. Philbrick

...formerly lived in Littleton 3 decades; 82

LANCASTER — Paul R. Philbrick, 82, a Lancaster resident who had previously lived in Littleton for three decades, died unexpectedly, Saturday, June 30, at Clinton Hospital in Clinton. He was the husband of Marjorie (Gregg) Philbrick.

He was born on April 25, 1919, in Goffstown, N.H., a son of the late Harry and Ethel (Johnson) Philbrick. He grew up in Weare, N.H., and graduated from Weare High School.

Mr. Philbrick moved to Massachusetts in 1941 to work as a machinist at General Electric. He began working at the former Digital Equipment Corp. in 1973, staying at that company until his retirement in 1987.

Mr. Philbrick had resided in Littleton from 1947 to 1978, when he moved to Lancaster. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Littleton.

In addition to his wife, he leaves two grandchildren, James D. Ragan and Deborah Philbrick, both residing in Florida.

He was also the father of Daniel W. Philbrick, who died in 1975, and the brother of the late Harry Philbrick Jr. and Ruth E. Philbrick.
