## Edgar P. Romilly... Littleton veterans agent, headed American Legion post; 85

LITTLETON — Edgar P. Romilly, 85, a Littleton resident nearly six decades and a leader in the town's veterans affairs, died Thursday, Nov. 4, at his home. He was the husband of Jean (Reed) Romilly, who died in 1997.

He was born in Boston's Brighton on Feb. 21, 1919, a son of the late Edgar and Nellie (McInerney) Romilly. He grew up in Newton and graduated from Newton High School. He received an associate's degree in business from Boston University. In addition to residing in Littleton, he maintained a home in Seminole, Fla.

During World War II, Mr. Romilly served in the Army and was a captain in the Quartermaster Corps.

Prior to his retirement, he pursued a career in sales and marketing for Nabisco Food Co. for many years.



He resided in Littleton since 1946, where he served the town as a veterans agent more than 30 years. Mr. Romilly was a member and past commander of the American Legion Post 249 in Littleton. He was also the Memorial Day parade chairman for many years and was instrumental in the founding of the Veterans Memorial at Littleton Common.

Mr. Romilly was a lifetime member of the Littleton-Westford Lodge of Elks. He was a communicant of St. Anne's Church in Littleton, where he was a member of the Holy Name Society.

Survivors include five sons, Paul D. Romilly of Wells, Maine, Robert R. Romilly, Mark W. Romilly and Kent C. Romilly, all of Littleton, and Richard Romilly of Westford. He also leaves seven grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
