Brian J. Rogers

LITTLETON — Brian J. Rogers, 36, of 51 Edsel Road, Littleton died suddenly at Emerson Hospital, Concord on Feb. 22.

He was born in Natick March 22, 1949, son of Joseph Rogers of Dunellon Florida and the late Cathryn (Horn) Rogers.

Mr. Rogers spent his early life in Natick and was a graduate of Natick High School, Class of 1968. He graduated from Northeastern University with an associate's degree in x-ray technology.

Mr. Rogers then went to work in Nuclear Medicine at Cardinal Cushing Hospital in Brockton,

and was later a Chief Technician at Framingham Union Hospital from 1974-1976. He then worked with New England Nuclear Corporation of Billerica as a Technical Services Representative and he also sold medical capital equipment for several companies.

Mr. Rogers was a former member of the Littleton Civic League, a member of the Citizens Energy Advisory Committee, and a member of the Church of the Good Shepherd in Acton where he was also a Christian Education Instructor.

Besides his father, he is survived by his wife, Dalene (Fuller)

Rogers, and two daughters, Carolyn F. and Kristen L. Rogers, all of Littleton; three brothers, Dennis Rogers of Conway, New Hampshire, Kenneth Rogers of Connecticut and Timothy Rogers of Natick; and a sister, Mrs. Carl (Patricia) Nelson of Acampo, California.

A funeral service was held Tuesday Feb. 25 at the Church of the Good Shepherd at 10 a.m. with Reverend William Huess officiating. Burial was in Westlawn Cemetery, Littleton.
