## Charles J. Robinson...Littleton, was engineer, veteran of two wars; 75

 LITTLETON — Charles J. Robinson, 75, a Littleton resident more than three decades who was a retired engineer and veteran of two wars, died Friday, Nov. 21, at his home. He was the husband of Patricia (Stevenson) Robinson, to whom he was married for 44 years.

He was born in Boston on July 2, 1928, son of Charles and Katherine (Reid) Robinson. He grew up in Somerville and graduated from Somerville High School in 1947, where he played high school hockey. He received his bachelor's degree in engineering from Boston University. In 1971, he moved in Littleton.

Mr. Robinson served in the Army during World War II. He also served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War, where he worked as an aviation and electrical mechanic.

Following the military, he worked as a pro-

toty engineer for Raytheon Co, and Sanders. Most recently he was an engineer for Barry Controls in Watertown.

Mr. Robinson was a former commander of the George Dillboy Veterans of Foreign Wars in Somerville. He was a member of the American Legion Post in Arlington, the Holy Name Society at St. Catherine's Church in Somerville, and a communicant of St. Anne's Church in Littleton.

Besides his wife, he is survived by his children, Kathleen Murphy of Pepperell, Charles H. Robinson of Majorca, Spain, James J. Robinson of Osterville, Thomas P. Robinson of Annandale, Va., Patricia LaLiberte of Gardner, Bernadette Robinson of Pepperell, Mary Christine Aqualino of Walpole, Anne M. Robinson of Anchorage, Alaska, and Eileen T. Robinson of Littleton; a sister, Catherine Breaker of Ipswich; and 18 grandchildren.
