

# Sheila Rivetts

## ...of Shirley, formerly of Littleton; 75

SHIRLEY — Sheila (Moore) Rivetts, 75, of Clark Road, and a former longtime Littleton resident, died Sunday, Feb. 7, at Leominster Hospital. She was the wife of the late Peter J. Rivetts.

She was born in Concord on Jan. 27, 1924, the daughter of the late Warren and Marjorie (Goddard) Moore.

Mrs. Rivetts made her home in Littleton most of her life and was a graduate of Littleton High School, Class of 1941. She worked during the war at Charlestown Navy Yard, where she performed clerical work and later at Fort Devens, repairing vehicles.

She married Mr. Rivetts after the war and they made their home in Littleton until her husband's death, when she moved to Shirley in 1981.

Mrs. Rivetts was very active and interested in antiques, and started her own small business in Westford. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in Littleton.

She is survived by three sons, James P. Rivetts of Tampa, Fla., Steven P. Rivetts of New Jersey and Michael D. Rivetts of Pepperell; three daughters, Betsy Wood of Lunenburg, Jane Baker of Sarasota, Fla. and Tricia Briggs of Tiverton, R.I.; a sister, Priscilla Lambert of Shirley; nine grandchildren and a great-grandchild.

Mrs. Rivetts was the mother of the late Daniel Rivetts, who died in 1971.
