Uncasville, Conn. — Julie Ann (Hosmer) Stoddard, 66, a former resident of Littleton and Groton who was a nurse in the area, died Wednesday, June 6, at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston. She was the wife of John E. Stoddard.

She was born in Ayer on May 9, 1941 daughter of the late Fred and Doris (Cunningham) Hosmer. She grew up in Littleton and graduated from Littleton High School.

She graduated from Mount Wachusett Community College in 1978 with a degree in nursing.
