

Vera Webber, 85

Littleton florist a half century

LITTLETON — Vera M. (Smith) Webber, a lifelong resident of King street and the founder with her husband of a local florist shop, died Tuesday in the home where she was born. She was 85.

Mrs. Webber and her husband, the late Horace I. Webber, founded the Littleton Conservatory, one of the first florist shops in the area more than 50 years ago. She remained active in the shop until her death.

She was a member of the First Church Unitarian and the Ladies Alliance in Littleton.

Mrs. Webber leaves a son, Philip S. of Littleton; four sisters, Jessie Smith of Lynn, Ethel E. Roberts of Williamstown, Vt., Dorothy J. Allen of Long Beach, Calif., and Marion V. Webber of Rochester, N.Y., and five grandchildren.

A memorial service will be conducted at 2 p.m. tomorrow at First Church Unitarian in Littleton.
