LITTLETON — Mary (Begley) Wilson, 81, of Wychwood Drive died yesterday, Jan. 4, at Deaconess Nashoba Hospital in Ayer. She was the wife of Kenneth A. Wilson, who died in 1997.

She was born in Spencer on Sept. 10, 1918, a daughter of the late Henry and Catherine (McKernan) Begley. She lived in Spencer early in life and graduated from David Prouty High School.

Mrs. Wilson worked in the electrical department of the Boston Navy Yard during World War II and for Digital Equipment Corp. in the 1960s.

She married in 1946 and had lived in Littleton since 1957. She was a communicant of St. Anne's Church.
