Bedford, Mass. - Silvana A.M. (Fratini) Burbine, 87, of Harwood Avenue, died Saturday, Dec. 13, 2008, at Nashoba Valley Medical Center, in Ayer. She was the wife of the late Thomas J. Burbine, who died in 2006.

She was born in Fiano, Italy on Aug. 22, 1921. Mrs. Burbine grew up in Italy where she met and married her husband in 1948 while he served in the U.S. Army. She came to the United States and first made her home in the Wakefield-Melrose area. They moved to Littleton in 1949 and traveled to various places including the Panama Canal Zone for 18 years before returning to Littleton.
