

George B. Curran...Littleton, engineer, congregational church member; 90

LITTLETON — George B. Curran, 90, a longtime resident of Littleton who was active in the Boy Scouts in town, died Thursday, Nov. 30, at Life Care Center of Nashoba Valley.

He was the husband of Natalie (Jones) Curran, who died in 1986.

He was born in Brookline, July 3, 1916, son of the late Joseph and Delilah (Meyers) Curran. He grew up in Brookline, and graduated from Brookline High School. He attended Wentworth Institute and MIT.

He married his wife in 1950, and they lived in Brookline until 1959, then moved to Littleton.

Before retiring, Mr. Curran worked as an engineer most of his life for RCA and MIT Lincoln Laboratory. He then worked part-time at PennWell Corp., in Littleton.

He was a member of Tahattawan Masonic Lodge AF & AM. He was active in Boy Scouts, serving as an assistant scoutmaster in Littleton.

He was an active member of the Littleton Congregational Church and the Harvard Church. He and his wife were members of two amateur theater groups.

He is survived by a daughter, Andrea Curran of Littleton; and a son, Frederic Curran of West Forks, Maine.
