


Q1 Did you attend one of the Littleton Station Village visioning session meetings in April?



Q2 If yes, did you attend:



Q3 How often do you go for a walk anywhere in Littleton?

























Q14 How often do you take the MBTA Commuter Rail to Boston or another destination on the Fitchburg Line?



Q15 When you take the train, do you board in Littleton or at another station?



Q16 If you board in Littleton, how do you get to the train station?



Q17 Even if you don't take the train in Littleton, how often do you go to the Taylor Street/Foster Street area?




