LITTLETON — Franklin "Frank" B. Edwards, 75, of 28 Mill Road died Tuesday at the Deaconess-Nashoba Hospital in Ayer. **MAY 9, 1995**

He was born in Littleton on June 9, 1919, a son of the late E. Brooks and Grace (Needham) Edwards.

A lifelong resident of Littleton, Mr. Edwards attended the Littleton School System and was a graduate of Lawrence Academy in Groton.

Prior to his retirement, he owned and operated the Citgo gas station on Littleton Common.

He served as a special police officer as well as a civil defense worker for many years.

Mr. Edwards played drums in the 1940s and 1950s in the Littleton Farmers Swing Band and was also a longtime member of the N.E.M.A.C. Antique Car Club.

Mr. Edwards is survived by his wife of 57 years, Virginia (Fletcher) Edwards of Littleton; two daughters, Mrs. Russell (Virginia) Sibley of Bedford, Dorothy Jarvis of Shirley; 10 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren.

He was also the father of the late Franklin B. Edwards, Jr., who died in 1974.
