Thanks for your response Maren.

I do not see any proposed activities that may have negative impacts to the Town's water resources or violate the Water Resource District use regulations. I was unable to find the actual square footage of impervious area (buildings excluded) added by increasing the number of on-site parking spaces on the plans, but as the applicant notes the total impervious coverage remains well under the 50% threshold in the Water Resource District.

We are still working with Nick Satmary from Sanctuary Medicinals to get the 5 groundwater monitoring wells requested by LELWD installed so that we can commence annual groundwater quality monitoring at this site. Hopefully this will be resolved relatively quickly.
