OBITUARY.—Monday afternoon June 23, occurred the death of one of the oldest residents of Littleton, Francis Flagg, aged 88 yrs. 4 mos. 8 dys. The funeral took place Wednesday afternoon at the home of his son, Chas. F. Flagg, which was his late residence. Rev. Mr. Enslin, pastor of the Baptist church of which Mr. Flagg was a member for sixty years, officiated.

About three months ago he was stricken with paralysis from which he never fully rallied. Prior to this he had always enjoyed good health.

Mr. Flagg was born in this town and has been a life long resident. Work, to him was always a pleasure; wherever he toiled improvement and thrift were the results. He was a kind neighbor and loyal citizen of the town, taking an interest in the prosperity of Littleton whether relating to the town as a whole or to the citizens individually. At different times he has held town offices and faithfully performed the duties incumbent upon them. To listen to his reminiscences of earlier days was interesting and instructive for his mind was stored with valuable information connecting the past with the present. His convictions for the right were always unwavering. A man of sturdy New England character and noble christian worth has gone from our midst and the loss will be felt by all who enjoyed his acquaintance.
